

The Big 4 Sawtell Holiday Park is a spacious caravan park located at 5 Lyons Road, Sawtell, with clubs, cafes and shops all within easy walking distance and only 8kms south of Coffs Harbour. The park's accommodation ranges from villas and cabins to van sites and shaded camping areas adjacent to Bonville Creek, with nature on your doorstep and with a short walk to the beach.

General Rally Information

Fuel:

- The nearest fuel is at Vignes Independent Service Station at 28 Sawtell Road (on the corner of Barber Close) on the way to Coffs Harbour.
- To the South, the nearest fuel is at the Liberty Service Station, 6kms away on Pine Creek Way.
- All rides will pass a service station within 6 kms of the Big 4 Sawtell Caravan Park.

Extra bike (s) - You can bring as many as you like, but each one must be recorded on your entry form to qualify for our rally insurance. If the second (or 3rd) bike will be ridden by a rider other than yourself, a fully paid entry in the name of the rider(s) must be submitted.

Extra rally badges - These will only be available if there are badges left over after all entrants have received one. If you want one, enquire at check - in to register your request. They will be \$6 each if available.

Motorcycle Only Swap Meet

On Friday afternoon, there will be a motorcycle only swap meet adjacent to the Sawtell Caravan Park camp kitchen. If entrants wish to set up a "stall" or a "tarp" to sell motorcycle parts, tools, motorcycle literature, motorcycle clothing or similar, could they please indicate so on the entry form and also contact Kerry Hendy, Swap co-ordinator on 0403-084-560 to ensure space is provided.

Raffles

There will be two types of raffle held during the rally and club week. The "big raffle" will be for a Suzuki GSX750E 1982 motorcycle. (See Rally Cover Page for likeness). The motorcycle has been cleaned, serviced and repaired and is in good original rallying condition. The tickets for the motorcycle are \$10 each and will be available on the rally entry or at various locations during the rally. The motorcycle raffle will be drawn at the Saturday night rally dinner.

There will also be a more traditional rally raffle with tickets sold for \$1/each and the raffle will be drawn from a tombola at the Saturday night rally dinner and the lucky winners will be able to select their prize from the donated sponsors' table.

Rally Routes and Programme

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, rally entrants will join Coffs Harbour members on their regular "Ride Calendar" events with some additional destinations and activities. Then on Friday, Saturday and Sunday there have been rides expressly designed from the Rally.

Tuesday, 21st May, Morning tea will be held at North Beach with entrants leaving Sawtell Caravan Park at 8.30am to Ride to Mylestrom to join the Coffs Harbour members for their regular Tuesday morning tea. After morning tea, at approximately 11.00am, there will be a guided ride to Dorrigo via Waterfall Way for entrants and club members, visiting Dangar Falls and having lunch at the Dorrigo Hotel.

Wednesday, 22nd May, Morning tea will be at the Idle Inn at Nana Glen with entrants leaving Sawtell Caravan Park at 8.30am to join Coffs Harbour members at the Ampol, Halls Road to ride to Nana Glen via the Orara Way and East Bank Road to Nana Glen. After morning tea at the Idle Inn, there will be a guided ride to Ulong via the Eastern Dorrigo Way with lunch at the Café in the Valley.

Thursday, 23rd May, Entrants will leave Sawtell Caravan Park at 9.30am for a guided ride to Bellingen's Butter Factory for brunch, after which entrants will return to Sawtell Caravan Park. At 3.00pm, there will be a "Bare Foot Bowls" challenge organized between Coffs

Harbour members and rally entrants. (I have been advised that there will be a special team of Harley Riders looking to challenge any visiting Indian riders who believe they have bowling credentials. Similarly Taree and Natureland clubs have experience teams, previously trained on the greens of Comboyne in interclub challenges) During bowls, nibblies will be provided free for both Coffs members and rally entrants. At the conclusion of the "Bare Foot Bowls", participants can retire to the Bowling Club to discuss their unexpected prowess and if desired, purchase dinner.

Friday, 24th May, Rally participants and club members will gather at the Sawtell Caravan Park camp kitchen at 11.00am for a free morning tea and a briefing for the Poker Run. To qualify for the Poker Run, both Coffs Harbour members and Rally entrants must register to receive their name tag and entry number. The first card will be handed out at 11.30am at the morning briefing and



will be marked with the participant's entry number. At 12 noon, the marshalled ride will leave Sawtell for Bruxner Park Lookout, where there will be a short stop, with a coffee cart available, and a second card marked with the entry number. From

Bruxner Park, the ride will go to Central Bucca where the marshal will provide the third card and then head onto Sandy Beach where there will be light refreshments provided free and a fourth card. The ride will then head back to Sawtell Caravan Park via Solitary Island Way

There will be a swap meet on the green adjacent to the camp kitchen from 4.00pm until 6.00pm and there will be the opportunity to have a cuppa or a cold beverage (\$2/beers and softies) at the camp kitchen.

At 6.00pm, the traditional free "Welcome" Barbeque will commence and the final card will be handed out and the winning hand declared.

The rider must hold a current motorcycle rider's licence. The entrant must ride in a safe manner and adhere to road traffic rules. The entrant must comply with directions of the marshals. We retain the right to refuse an entry.

In the event of a breakdown: The back-up will not wait while you make roadside repairs. Once the back-up vehicle reaches you, just have your bike transported to the next stop where you can attempt a repair if you wish. If you do decline to be transported, *you will be on your own*. You must be a registered entrant to the rally or a member of the Coffs Harbour Motorcycle Restorers' Club to use the back-up trailer with first preference to entrants.

In the event of an accident: Stay together and wait for a marshal, then if unable to help, move on.

Note: If you wish to compete in the rally, receive a rally badge, or come to the rally dinner, or come to the rally without marshalling, yet still have meals, then you should complete a rally entry form.
