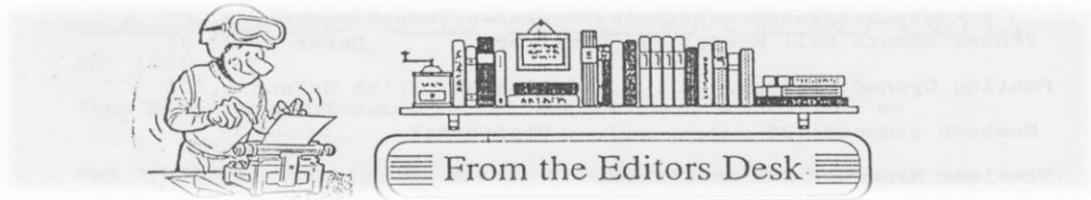

LOGBOOK You must always carry your Logbook and Membership Card when riding/driving your club bike/car.

Your logbook does not need to be filled out when you are going on a club calendar ride. But you need to follow that route listed on the ride calendar leaving from your home address and returning in the direction of your home address and make sure your bike has been registered for the day by one of our Captains.

When to fill in your Logbook. You must record return journeys that are not part of club-organised events and each day of maintenance and personal use in the logbook.

CLUB RALLY Our Club Rally is held Annually in late May.

Membership renewal.

The end of the club's financial year is 30th June. Your membership expired on that date. This means you cannot ride a conditionally registered bike after the 30th of June unless you have paid your membership subscription.

As far as the RMS is concerned, if the owner of the vehicle is not financial with his club, then the bike is unregistered, irrespective of when the bike's registration runs out.

Business Arising from Previous Minutes:

Website – Che – the draft mainframe has been sent through for our comments and input. This was shown to members at the meeting and we had some great feedback. Members have asked for a forum type private page where they can add comments, photos and have discussions about who is going on rides, where to meet etc. This will be passed on to Che for their continued development. Remembering the build is approximately 12 weeks, if there is something you would like to see, it needs to be built in **now**, not in six months time. Of course, not all things are possible, but we will do our best to achieve the outcome members would like to see.

The website will be laptop/tablet, desktop and mobile friendly with simple easy to use buttons to find the information needed.

General Business:

Rally – The committee has made the decision to cancel the rally for this year. The forecast is not looking great, and we have a duty of care to our participants to keep everyone as safe as possible. Even if it is not raining next weekend, the roads are in a very poor condition which could cause damage to bikes or injury. The raffle bike will still be drawn on Saturday 24th May 2025. We have now booked the Mick Stanley Room as we do not have the numbers for the Club to cater to us in the Princess Room. We will still meet, have dinner and draw the ticket for the raffle bike and second prize. An email will be sent out to everyone who has entered the rally. Sponsors will also be notified in relation to the rally cancellation.

Vehicle Inspections – We think it is a grey area for our Club, even though RMS allow the registration of vehicles in our Club, we are uncertain if we are actually allowed to have them on our club register. We will report back next meeting. Please be aware, our inspectors are not issuing a pink slip, we are only issuing a “fit for purpose” declaration, there is nothing in our declaration to say the vehicle is roadworthy, examiners are signing a declaration, the registered applicant is responsible for the vehicle to ensure it complies with current rules and the vehicle is roadworthy. It is worth noting, the use of the word “**vehicle**” from an RMS perspective relates to all modes of transport, ie, tractors, cars, trucks and motorcycles.

Positions Vacant – Secretary & Website Administrator, Merchandise; Editor and President. Although it is important to remember, that ALL positions are declared vacant at the AGM. It is up to members to nominate members to take positions, please discuss this with anyone you wish to nominate prior to the AGM so it is not a surprise on the night to ensure the meeting goes smoothly.

Secretary – Trisha has been doing this role for the last four years, the constitution states a person can only hold the same committee position for a maximum of 3 years. This will be the last year and it is time for someone else to sit in as Secretary. A Club Manual has been developed as a live document. This can be updated by the Secretary for roles as new committee members have new ideas and the ever evolving way of managing a Club.

Merchandise – Una is recovering from her leg injury and is unable to carry the stock around to functions and meetings to sell to members. We need someone to take on the merchandise either temporarily or permanently, as Una and Mick both recover from a pretty hectic year. Trisha currently has the merchandise, please feel free to reach out if this is something you would like to know more about. We have a bit of stock on hand, let us know if you need a new jumper, hoodie or shirt.

Editor – Lara has advised this will be her last year as editor. Lara has been in this position for many years, and has done a great job. The Editor's laptop has been set up and has the template for the newsletter saved. The Editor will be responsible for sending out the club magazine bi-monthly, gather articles and information for the newsletter, keep the distribution list up to date and ensure it is sent out on time. The newsletter is also provided to the website administrator to be uploaded to the website.

President – The President role has been in Nigel's hands for the past few years, he has done a great job promoting the club in the community and chairing the meetings. He has been supported by Vice President Peter Watson, who stands in for Nigel while he is away.

Website Administrator – Wayne Adams has been in this role for well over 10 years, and the club appreciates all he does to keep it updated. With the development continuing of the new website, Wayne has taken the opportunity to stand down and let someone else take over the role.

Machine Examiners – It was asked whether our machine examiners need any type of qualification and whether we scrutinise examiners as to whether they are suitable candidates for the position. All of the machine examiners in our Club have either mechanical background or extensive knowledge about motorcycles. All positions for examiners are full.

46 renewals straight online, 260 membership cards have been printed. Remember if you do not have a current membership, your registration is not current as you must be a financial member of a club to be riding a bike on club registration.

Business Arising from Previous Minutes:

Website – Che – the draft mainframe has been sent through for our comments and input. This was shown to members at the meeting and we had some great feedback. Members have asked for a forum type private page where they can add comments, photos and have discussions about who is going on rides, where to meet etc. This will be passed on to Che for their continued development. Remembering the build is approximately 12 weeks, if there is something you would like to see, it needs to be built in **now**, not in six months time. Of course, not all things are possible, but we will do our best to achieve the outcome members would like to see.

The website will be laptop/tablet, desktop and mobile friendly with simple easy to use buttons to find the information needed.

Bike winner – Keith Phillips – Keith collected his bike from Pete Watson, he is over the moon with his win and we send our congratulations!

General Business:

Rally – Most refunds have now been processed and the account reconciled. We are still holding a bit of money which needs to be refunded. We will call each entrant again to obtain account details to finalise this process. From the raffle bike proceeds, we are donating a total of \$4,000 divided between two charities. Pete's Place and Con Do Cancer Trust. Both charities have been contacted and advised.

Pete's Place:

The St Vincent de Paul Society has assisted in providing a drop in service for people experiencing, or at risk of homelessness. It was established in 2018 with assistance from Coffs Harbour South Rotary, Coffs Harbour City Council through an infrastructure grant and a bequest from local Peter Grealy. Originally, Pete's Place provided access to basic needs and provisions such as laundry and shower facilities, food, clothing, blankets and tents as well as qualified staff to provide assessment, support, casework and referrals. Homelessness has escalated in our area over the past few years, with an average of 70 people a day seeking assistance.

CanDo Cancer Trust:

CanDo is the only local charity that financially supports patients and families attending the Mid North Coast Cancer Institute. They are a fully registered charity with tax deductible status and are audited each year. Their funds are raised by charity events. They have helped 1,802 local families and raised \$855,000 for this support service. CanDo assist those in need in the region by paying household bills or providing food or fuel cards. In an effort to ensure funds remain in the local area and help those most in need in our community, the trust committee distribute money to patients affected by cancer. The Catchment area for CanDo is any patient that attends the MNCCI at the Coffs Harbour Hospital. They are a fully volunteer run organisation and do not have any administration fees.

Positions Vacant –*It is important to remember, that ALL positions are declared vacant at the AGM. It is up to members to nominate members to take positions, please discuss this with anyone you wish to nominate prior to the AGM so it is not a surprise on the night to ensure the meeting goes smoothly.*

- **Secretary** – *Trisha has been doing this role for the last four years, the constitution states a person can only hold the same committee position for a maximum of 3 years. This will be the last year and it is time for someone else to sit in as Secretary. A Club Manual has been developed as a live document. This can be updated by the Secretary for roles as new committee members have new ideas and the ever evolving way of managing a Club.*
- **Merchandise** – *Una is recovering from her leg injury and is unable to carry the stock around to functions and meetings to sell to members. We need someone to take on the merchandise either temporarily or permanently, as Una and Mick both recover from a pretty hectic year. Trisha currently has the merchandise, please feel free to reach out if this is something you would like to know more about. We have a bit of stock on hand, let us know if you need a new jumper, hoodie or shirt.*
- **Editor** – *Lara has advised this will be her last year as editor. Lara has been in this position for many years, and has done a great job. The Editor's laptop has been set up and has the template for the newsletter saved. The Editor will be responsible for sending out the club magazine bi-monthly, gather articles and information for the newsletter, keep the distribution list up to date and ensure it is sent out on time. The newsletter is also provided to the website administrator to be uploaded to the website.*
- **President** – *The President role has been in Nigel's hands for the past few years, he has done a great job promoting the club in the community and chairing the meetings. He has been supported by Vice President Peter Watson, who stands in for Nigel while he is away.*
- **Website Administrator** – *Wayne Adams has been in this role for well over 10 years, and the club appreciates all he does to keep it updated. With the*

development continuing of the new website, Wayne has taken the opportunity to stand down and let someone else take over the role.

Glenn O'Grady – *proposes that everyone attending a meeting can go into a draw to win 2 x \$20 meal vouchers. It will be like a Club credit card, valid for 3 years, but you need to be at the meeting to be able to win this prize. Two separate people will be able to win this. No cost for this, it is a member benefit.*
