Your logbook does not need to be filled out when you are going on a club calendar ride. But, you need to follow that route listed on the ride calendar leaving from your home address and returning to your home address and make sure your bike has been registered for the day by one of our Captains. *When to fill in your Logbook.* You must record return journeys that are not part of club-organised events and each day of maintenance and personal use in the logbook.

The Registered operator must be a member of an authorised motoring club when riding/driving their club bike or car.

What is "Club Week 2024"?

Club Week, 2024 is a celebration of the Coffs Harbour and District Motorcycle Restorers' Club, 43rd Year and will be run in conjunction with the 40th Restore and Ride Rally.

The theme is to provide a week of activities and benefits for members. This will include a full week



of rides built on our traditional ride calendar events but then extended on each day, with extra special events and culminating with the Annual Rally now in its 40th year.

Members will have the opportunity to come to either Club Week, the 40th Annual Rally, or both events.

It will be necessary to put in an entry form as many of the events are funded by the Coffs Restorers' Club and events

need to be pre-booked with venues and numbers are needed to pre-order food or provide subsidies.

Club Week Information

Motorcycle Only Swap Meet

On Friday afternoon, 24th May, there will be a motorcycle only swap meet adjacent to the Sawtell Caravan Park camp kitchen. If club week entrants wish to set up a "stall" or a "tarp" to sell motorcycle parts, tools, motorcycle literature, motorcycle clothing or similar, could they please indicate so on the entry form and also contact Kerry Hendy, Swap co-ordinator on 0403-084-560 to ensure space is provided.

Raffles

There will be two types of raffle held during the rally and club week. The "big raffle" will be for a Suzuki GSX750E 1982 motorcycle. (See Rally Cover Page for likeness). The motorcycle has been cleaned, serviced and repaired and is in good original rallying condition. The tickets for the motorcycle are \$10 each and will be available on the rally entry or at various locations during the rally. The motorcycle raffle will be drawn at the Saturday night rally dinner and all profits will be donated to the Westpac Rescue Helicopter

There will also be a more traditional rally raffle with tickets sold for \$1/each and the raffle will be drawn from a tombola at the Saturday night rally dinner and the lucky winners will be able to select their prize from the donated sponsors' table.

Club Week Events 21st to 26th May, 2024

On Tuesday, and Wednesday, Club Week entrants will have a modified ride calendar to provide either the usual short rides or an extended ride. On Thursday there will be a brunch ride followed by an afternoon of lawn bowls at the Sawtell Bowling Club. Then following on the Friday, there will be a poker run and free barbeque with an afternoon "Bike Only Swap Meet. Finally on the Saturday and Sunday, there have been rides expressly designed for the 40th Restore and Ride Rally.

Activities and Programme by Date.

Tuesday, 21st May, Morning tea will be held at North Beach café with members going directly to North Beach. If there are any early Rally entrants, they will leave Sawtell Caravan Park at 8.30am to ride to Mylestrom to join the Coffs Harbour members for their regular Tuesday morning tea. After morning tea, at approximately 11.00am, there will be a ride to Dorrigo via Waterfall Way for entrants and club members, visiting Dangar Falls and having lunch at the Dorrigo Hotel. For those wishing for a bit of extra activity, riders will either return via Waterfall Way or President Nigel Locke, will lead any interested riders across the Eastern Dorrigo Way via Megan to Ulong and then back to Coffs Harbour. (This will include some dirt roads and will be weather dependent)

Wednesday, 22nd May, Morning tea will be at the Idle Inn at Nana Glen via the Orara Way and East Bank Road to Nana Glen. leaving from the Ampol, Halls Road at 9.00am. Any early Rally entrants will leave Sawtell Caravan Park at 8.30am to join Coffs Harbour members at the Ampol. After morning tea at the Idle Inn, there will be a guided ride to Ulong via the Eastern Dorrigo Way with lunch at the Ulong RSL or Café in the Valley. For the very adventurous, the return route for off-road bikes will be via Lowanna, Moleton and down to Nana Glen.

Thursday, 23rd May, Club Week entrants will meet Sawtell Caravan Park at 9.30am and join any early Rally entrants for a guided ride to Bellingen's Butter Factory for brunch, after which Rally entrants will return to Sawtell Caravan Park. At 3.00pm, there will be a "Bare Foot Bowls" challenge organized between Coffs Harbour members and rally entrants. (It has been advised that there will be a special team of Harley Riders looking to challenge any visiting Indian





riders who believe they have bowling credentials. Similarly Taree and Natureland clubs have experienced teams, previously trained on the greens of Comboyne in interclub challenges) During bowls, nibblies will be provided free for both Coffs members and rally entrants. At the conclusion of the "Bare Foot Bowls", participants can retire to the Bowling Club to discuss their unexpected prowess and if desired, purchase dinner. Friday, 24th May. At 11.00am there will be a free morning tea in the Sawtell Caravan Park camp kitchen and a briefing for the Poker Run. To qualify for the Poker Run, both Coffs Harbour members and Rally entrants must register to receive their name tag and entry number. The record cards and first card will be handed out at 11.30am at the morning briefing and will be marked with the entry number. At 12.00 midday, the marshalled ride will leave Sawtell for Bruxner Park Lookout,



where there will be a short stop, a coffee cart, and a second card drawn. From Bruxner Park, the ride will go to Central Bucca where the marshal will provide the third card and then head onto Sandy Beach where there will be light refreshments provided free and a fourth card. The ride will then head back to Sawtell Caravan Park.

There will be a swap meet on the green adjacent to the camp kitchen from 4.00pm until 6.00pm and there will be the opportunity to have a cuppa or a cold beverage (\$2/beers and softies) at the camp kitchen

At 6.00pm, the traditional free "Welcome" barbeque will commence and the final card will be handed out and the winner declared.

The winner of the Poker Draw will be decided according to the posted criteria and will receive a prize. (raffle tickets for the bike or a sumptuous gift donated by one of our sponsors)



Saturday, 25th May Breakfast will commence at 7.00am in the camp kitchen and at 9.00am the ride will leave Sawtell Caravan Park and follow the "Old Pacific Highway" to Nambucca before turning off to Bowraville. At Bowraville, morning tea will be served by Phoenix Disability Services in the COLA at the Bowraville Central School. There will be time for members to visit the Frank Partridge VC memorial museum in Bowraville while the morning tea is running. After morning tea, the ride will proceed to Taylors Arm via Wilson

Road and Congarinni North Road onto the Taylors Arm Road to go to the "Pub with No Beer" for lunch and a beer? Any members registered to assist as marshals will receive free breakfast, morning tea and lunch. The ride will return via the "Old Pacific" highway to Sawtell.

Presentation dinner: The dinner, raffles and entertainment will be at the Sawtell RSL Club, within
walking distance of Sawtell Caravan Park. Be sure to bring your meal tickets.If you have

special dietary requirements, please advise when returning the Entry Form.

Sunday, 26th May. Breakfast will commence at 7.00am and go for about an hour. After breakfast the ride will leave at 9.00am and go North to Bruxner Park and then via Bucca Road and the Orara Valley Way to Glenreagh where the Glenreagh Rural Fire Service will provide a complimentary "Sunday Sausage". Any members registered to assist as marshals will receive free breakfast, and "Sunday Sausage".

Note: If you wish to compete in the rally, receive a rally badge, or come to the rally dinner, or come to the rally without marshalling, yet still have meals, then you should complete a rally entry form.

Conditions of entry: The motorcycle/s ridden must be currently registered on full or historic vehicle registration or have an approved RMS permit and be in safe working order. The rider must hold a current motorcycle rider's licence. The entrant must ride in a safe manner and adhere to road traffic rules. The entrant must comply with directions of the marshals. We retain the right to refuse an entry.

In the event of a breakdown: There will be a back up vehicle on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The back-up will not wait while you make roadside repairs. Once the back-up vehicle reaches you, just have your bike transported to the next stop where you can attempt a repair if you wish. If you do decline to be transported, *you will be on your own*. You must be a registered entrant to the rally or a member of the Coffs Harbour Motorcycle Restorers' Club to use the back-up trailer with first preference to entrants.

In the event of an accident: Stay together and wait for a marshal on rally days, then if unable to help, move on.

Indemnity: I agree to be bound by the rules, regulations and directions of the Coffs Harbour & District Motorcycle Restorers Club Inc. and enter and participate in the Club Week at my own risk,

The North Coast Classic Motorcycle Show & Swap No.4 Sunday 18th February 2024



The fourth in a great series where all profits go to the Ballina Hospital Auxiliary. The weather was fine although a little hot and humid, so much so that it was a late afternoon and night ride up the expressway from Coffs to avoid the heat with only a little rain at Little Italy and a late night arrival. As someone who avoids the expressways, it was a good reminder of the lack of fuel on the expressway. After Coffs, the only fuel on the highway before Ballina is at Halfway Creek and Ballina is over 200kms if you don't fuel straight away at Halfway Creek or go into Grafton. Otherwise, it is off the highway and at night the local service stations are closed. A bit of problem on older bikes with small tanks and big fuel consumption! On arrival there were quite a few caravans and camper vans staying at the Alstonville Showground, but for those of us with a tent it was into the open fronted pavilion for fear of a torrential North Coast drenching.

The Show and Swap was an early start with the Hospital Auxiliary volunteers getting the food sizzling and the hot drinks coming from 6am onwards. The swap meet had a strong showing of British parts, with a selection of Japanese parts. The traders seemed to do a good trade and there were quite a few happy customers. The bike show had an eclectic mix of British and American older bikes from the Forties through to the Sixties and then there was mainly Japanese, with a little bit of Italian into the later years. There were even some older Australian bikes from the Twenties and Thirties. The best way to show a sample is with photos.

A great event and well worth putting on the calendar for next year. Congratulations need to go to the hardworking duo of Nancy and Col McAndrew who do a great job putting the show together.

There will also be a more traditional rally raffle with tickets sold for \$1/each and the raffle will be drawn from a tombola at the Saturday night rally dinner and the lucky winners will be able to select their prize from the donated sponsors' table.

Rally Routes and Programme

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, rally entrants will join Coffs Harbour members on their regular "Ride Calendar" events with some additional destinations and activities. Then on Friday, Saturday and Sunday there have been rides expressly designed from the Rally.

Tuesday, 21st May, Morning tea will be held at North Beach with entrants leaving Sawtell Caravan Park at 8.30am to Ride to Mylestrom to join the Coffs Harbour members for their regular Tuesday morning tea. After morning tea, at approximately 11.00am, there will be a guided ride to Dorrigo via Waterfall Way for entrants and club members, visiting Dangar Falls and having lunch at the Dorrigo Hotel.

Wednesday, 22nd May, Morning tea will be at the Idle Inn at Nana Glen with entrants leaving Sawtell Caravan Park at 8.30am to join Coffs Harbour members at the Ampol, Halls Road to ride to Nana Glen via the Orara Way and East Bank Road to Nana Glen.
