

CLUB RIDES See the ride Calendar in the Magazine for upcoming rides, Rally's & Events. LOGBOOK You must always carry your Logbook and Membership Card when riding/driving your club bike/car.

Your logbook does not need to be filled out when you are going on a club calendar ride. But you need to follow that route listed on the ride calendar leaving from your home address and returning in the direction of your home address and make sure your bike has been registered for the day by one of our Captains.

When to fill in your Logbook. You must record return journeys that are not part of cluborganised events and each day of maintenance and personal use in the logbook.

CLUB RALLY Our Club Rally is held Annually in late May.

Membership renewal.

The end of the club's financial year is 30th June. Your membership expired on that date. This means you cannot ride a conditionally registered bike after the 30th June unless

you have paid your membership subscription.

As far as the RMS is concerned, if the owner of the vehicle is not financial with his club, then the bike is unregistered, irrespective of when the bike's registration runs out.



MEMBERS SECTION

Members are required to attend at least three events during a membership year and can be by way of attending a Club meeting, ride days, the rally, Club Christmas party or Membership BBQ Day.

Members are required to abide by the Club's Constitution, refer to the Club website.

The Club will hold an annual BBQ at a venue for members to attend from 9.00am to 3.00pm on the third Sunday in June. This is a casual get together to have a chat, pay your membership for the following year prior to the due date of 1 July.

Our members try to attend our meetings on a regular basis, and it is hoped that you will be able to do so as well to maximise your enjoyment and fun as being a member of our Club. Your involvement and contribution are essential for the Club's continued success.

If paying in cash, please put the correct money in an envelope with your name and membership number on the front of the envelope. Hand deliver to the Treasurer.

PLEASE DO NOT POST CASH!

If membership payments are not received by the **30th September** of each year, you will need to complete a new member application and begin the process from the start which also attracts a Club Application fee of \$20.00 in additional to your annual membership of \$50.00.

Log Book Who is eligible to use a log book

Getting a log book allows you to use vehicles registered under the Historic Vehicle and Classic Vehicle Schemes for up to 60 days per year for maintenance and personal use, outside of cluborganised events. Each day of general use must be recorded in your log book.



You may only opt in for a Classic and Historic Vehicle Log Book if:

- you are a recognised club member with NSW conditional registration.
- your club participates in the log book scheme.

Check the <u>Historic vehicle clubs list (PDF 857.58KB)</u> or the eligibility requirements for the <u>classic vehicle scheme</u> for participating clubs.

You can view the <u>Historic and classic vehicles log book and club runs fact sheet (PDF 119.96KB)</u> for more information about using the log book.

Using the log book

You can use the log book as soon as it's issued to record the days you use the vehicle for maintenance or personal use.

The number of days allocated depends on the remaining length of conditional registration when the log book is issued.

Days allocated and registration length.

Remaining registration	Number of days vehicle can be used (allocated log book days)
Up to 3 months	15
Over 3 and up to 6 months	30
Over 6 and up to 9 months	45
over 9 months	60

You must carry the log book in the vehicle when it is in use.

When to notify the club of vehicle use

If you're using a log book, you don't need to tell the club which days you are driving the vehicle for personal use or maintenance – unless you have an agreement with the club to notify them.

However, you must record return journeys that are not part of club-organised events and each day of general use in the log book.


Out & About







2025 Rally

Dear Fellow Motorcycle Enthusiasts,

The Classic & Enthusiasts Motor Cycle Club of New South Wales Inc. extends a cordial invitation to your club and members to join us for the 42nd Annual Orange Country Bike Rally, to be held on the 15th and 16th February, 2025.

We encourage all participants to be vaccinated against COVID. If you have any symptoms of COVID, please do not attend.

Closing date is Friday 31st January. You are able to pay by cheque (mail), or EFT. You can return entries via email, or by post, details are on the entry form.

If you require on site camping or bunk room accommodation, please indicate on the entry form and pay in advance. You have the option of not purchasing a Polo Shirt for a reduced entry fee.

The Rally is organized by the Central West Branch, with the Rally Headquarters again being the Scout Camp near Lake Canobolas in the picturesque Towac Valley, approximately 10km West of Orange. Check-in is from 8.00am Saturday and departure at 9.00am. The ride this year will be approximately 200km, and will be marshalled and have back-up trailers.

The ride will take us through Blayney and Neville with morning tea provided by Blayney Public School and then on to lunch at Neville Public School. Fuel will be available at Blayney.

The Saturday night presentation dinner will as usual be held at the Scout Camp, 6.30pm for 7.00pm (BYO alcohol) at \$35 per head – please order and pay in advance with the entry form to allow us to make arrangements for catering. A self catered light breakfast of tea, coffee and toast is also available at the Scout Camp both mornings for a cost of \$5.00.

On the Sunday morning there will be a ride of approximately 80kms around the local area including a coffee stop, departing the Scout Camp with an 8.30am start, returning at approximately 11am. This is an unmarshalled ride.
