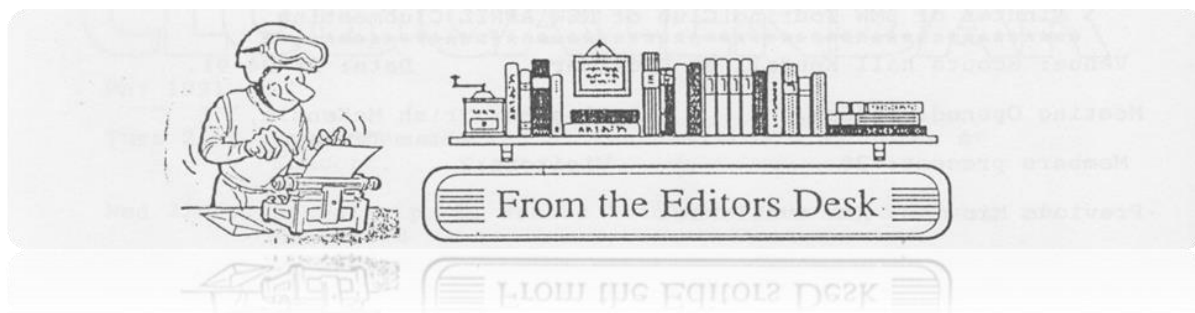

Out and About Natureland Rally

South West Rocks, 4th -6th November, 2022.

Our rally started on Thursday as we had a house booked and the minimum rental period was 3 days. So down on Thursday and Treasurer, Eddie, cooked up a delicious spaghetti Bolognese. On Friday it was a morning stroll on the beach and a swim and then at midday it was meeting time at the South West Rocks Country Club. The “residents” were joined by Gary Mackay who rode down



during the morning for a cuppa and the afternoon ride. There was a good roll up of about 60 bikes and after a few greetings and catchups it was on the road and down to the old Highway and heading south and then into Gladstone and around the Belmore River Road through Austral Eden and then back to Smoky Cape lighthouse. It was a steep climb up the stairs to the lighthouse, but with excellent views up and down the coast making the climb worthwhile. Overall a pleasant run of about 70 kilometres with fine weather.

Friday night bought a gathering of about 50 entrants for a barbeque and registration at the Country Club. Although there were more entrants, many had stayed over at Hat Head and had decided to stay close to the Hat Head Bowling Club rather than riding over and back to South West Rocks for the evening.

Saturday morning was a bit dismal with solid raining as we gathered at



Horseshoe Bay to begin the rally. Some pulled the pin before we left as the rain seemed to be settling in. Even so about 60 hardy riders left for the run to Gladstone, where there were another 40 riders who had ridden in from Hat Head. It was then out along Belmore River Road to Crescent Head before turning west to Kempsey and then onto

Sherwood Hall. The further we rode the better the weather became, so most had dried out by Sherwood Hall where a hearty morning tea with hot cuppas and cakes awaited. Most enjoyable.

It was then a pleasant and basically dry ride into Beechwood for more food. There was a mix of lunches varying from a sit-down meal at the hall to picnics

out on the grassed area adjacent to the road, west of the hall. We set up “Café Coffs” in the old tennis shelter shed and dined on sandwiches of ham, cheese, salami, bananas, assorted biscuits, and even “coral trout”, while Lance boiled the billy so we could wash down the meal with a hot



beverage. The judging was done during lunch and at the conclusion of there was a lively presentation conducted by MC Keith Miller who managed to allocate all the winners’ medallions. The run back was via Kempsey and out along the Macleay River, past the old Kinchela Boys home.

We dined at our residence at South West Rocks and had a few visitors as the traditional rally dinner had been cancelled due to the Country Club trying to impose an exorbitant hiring fee for use of the dining room! Yet again Treasurer Eddie stepped up to the hob and came up with a chicken curry with yogurt and chutneys, another “piece de resistance”. The meal was washed down with a fine selection of beers and red wines and concluded by sticky date and ice cream prepared by retired president, Rob.

A bit of a slow start on Sunday morning and cleaning the house and packing bikes and vehicles, then off to Horseshoe Bay for the morning roll call. A short ride saw us in Stuarts Point where we had a break before heading home. Some of the riders headed back to Horseshoe Bay for a brunch, but the call of home was too strong for the Coffs entrants.



A most enjoyable rally with great marshalling and rides. There were even rumours that the rally may return to Hat Head, depending upon negotiations with the Bowling Club. What ever happens, the Natureland rally is a great way to finish the rally year before the silly season, so keep your ears to the ground and book early for next year.

Saturday the 17th December at 12:00 noon - Australian Eastern Daylight Saving Time (Tasmanian Time).

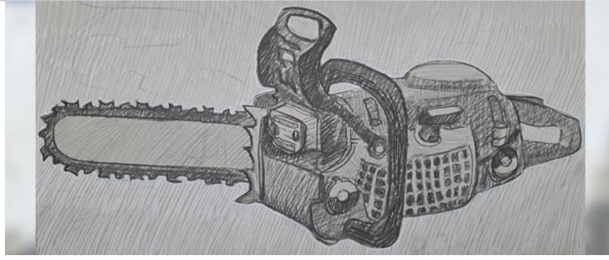

The 2023 Restore and Ride Rally

A committee is needed to get together and plan the 2023 rally.

This ideally requires about 10 people to commit to taking responsibility for some aspect of the planning & pre rally jobs that have to be in place prior to the rally.

Then there are the jobs that someone has to commit to over the weekend of the rally.

Rally co-ordinator. Schedules committee meetings, and in the lead up to rally checks that jobs that are supposed to be done are actually being done. At the rally he/she is the front person to answer questions and sort out problems, if they arise.

Rally treasurer. - Handles all aspects of costs related to rally. Usually taken on by club treasurer, but as rally has a separate account can be done by some one else.

Ride planner(s) - We have Fri ,Sat, Sun rides and these can be all planned by one person or each ride planned by a different person. Which ever it is the planner is responsible for establishing the route, the marshalling points, morning tea and/or lunch stops and liaising with who ever they choose to cater at these points.

Marshall organizer - Liaise with ride planner(s) to know how many marshals are need on each ride and be familiar with ride routes. Keep a list of those who volunteer for marshalling.

Entrant mail out & entry recording. Send out e-mail and surface mail entries and info to listed previous rally entrants. Keep a record of entries received and data related to bikes,(for judging purposes.)

Sponsors and publicity- We have about 25 businesses who sponsor our rally. Some need up to 3 months notice, and all will need a follow up visit . Need 5 members to volunteer to approach 5 sponsors each.

Rally entry form and Info about rally - Some one to format this once the rally details are established after the initial committee meeting.

Rally Badges - Establishing colour, quantity and ordering from supplier.

Rally Trophies - Once committee decides style and number of trophies required, purchase them and have engraved.

Friday Bar B.Q. and Breakfast logistics - Order and store food and drink needed. This done in week leading to rally when entry numbers are known.

The above jobs are required leading up to the rally.

The following jobs are required to be done over rally weekend.
