












Rob's Sunday Ride

Ward's Trip to Glen Innes, 5th-6th October

The weekend of 5-6th October was the weekend of the Coffs Club ride to Glen Innes. As planned Nick and I met at BP North, Urunga to ride to the predetermined club rendezvous at the Caltex South, Coffs Harbour. At 9.30am, we realised that we were it and so off we road on our "Jap Crap" on the back road to Grafton.

No problems till Nick decided to turn off towards Coutts Crossing on a shortcut to bypass Grafton which resulted in a flat front tyre to his preferred ride. (Suzuki)

This then resulted in a 25km ride at 50kmh to Grafton to hopefully repair his



Log Books

The RMS has sent out the letter on the following page and confirms the rumour that the log book trial is going to become permanent. I registered a bike in mid-October and the attendant at the RMS tried to do it all on line, but it hadn't been upgraded. I was advised that "very soon", I would be able to do my Log book re-registrations "on line" and print out my own log book. The attendant did not mention how we would have to submit our inspection forms?!!



Historic and Classic Vehicle Log Book

GOVERNMENT Transport for NSW recently conducted a review of the Log Book Trial, operating under the Historic and Classic Vehicle Schemes. As part of the Trial, Transport for NSW received feedback from a broad range of stakeholders to evaluate the effectiveness of the program.

From 1 October 2019, the Log Book will become a permanent feature of the Historic and Classic Vehicle Schemes. Transport for NSW will deliver a number of improvements to the schemes over the next 12 months based on the feedback received during the review.

Existing requirements introduced during the Trial will continue to apply to participants, including:

- Vehicles registered under the Historic and Classic Vehicle Schemes can be operated for 60 days of general road use each year, outside of club organised events.
- Each day of general use must be recorded in a Log Book issued at Service NSW branches.
- Owners wishing to opt into the Log Book program should be a member of a Transport for NSW recognised Classic or Historic Vehicle Club, or Approved Organisation participating in the Log Book program.

Information and updates to the Log Book program and proposed improvements will be communicated to Historic and Classic Vehicle Clubs and Approved Organisations in writing in the coming weeks.

Please ensure Transport for NSW has up-to-date club contact details, including a valid email address, so we can inform you of upcoming changes to the Log Book.


