So let's try again and a dirt/road ride is included in the April ride calendar. There are also some more meet and greets with other clubs as these are proving popular.

The Annual Coffs Harbour Rally. (26th -28th May, 2017)

First a bit of background for some of our new members and for others who have yet to enjoy the camaraderie of rallies.

Basically all clubs hold an annual rally. These rallies provide a focus for each club to:

- Showcase their local area
- Promote the local businesses who support their clubs
- Raise some funds for running their clubs (often this is minimal and any excess is usually donated to local charities though some may go towards maintenance for club trailers, etc)
- Display the club's members' motorcycles
- Participate and reciprocate in the restoration and preservation of old motorcycles in a practical and social way.

All club rallies tend to follow the same basic format as our own rally.

The Coffs Harbour Rally is based at the Sawtell Caravan Park, which is central to our region and can provide accommodation for our usual attendance of around 100 persons and 70 bikes. Like all clubs we charge an entry fee which entitles



the entrant to the rally badge, all the details of the rally, maps of the area, the support of a back-up trailer and a series of marshalled rides in the local area. On top of the entry fee, there are usually charges to cover meals during the rally and to attend the presentation dinner.

Over the three days of the rally, the club's members volunteer to be marshals to direct our visitors around the rally courses. The Friday ride is aimed at older machines and as a consequence is often shorter and does not depart the

Sawtell Caravan Park until midday. The Saturday ride is the main rally ride and is about 200kms long and includes stops for morning tea and lunch. During this ride, all the entrants' bikes are "judged" in categories depending on the age of the motorcycle. The Saturday night presentation is the opportunity to socialize and to award "trophies and prizes" for motorcycles and riders. Sunday's ride is usually a very social ride to say farewell and usually ends with a brunch before entrants head home.

Our club has a rally committee, which will organize and plan the marshalled rides, advertise the rally to other clubs, organize the sorting and collection of

entries, make up the rally packs, either cook or organize the cooking of meals. ensure the back-up vehicles are ready and there are tow vehicles and drivers, and numerous other smaller tasks.

For the members it is a chance to help out, display and ride your bikes and meet and greet motorcycle enthusiasts from other clubs. Our treasurer, Rob Popplewell is our rally convener and either call him or catch him at a meeting and offer your support. Remember, many hands make light work!

It should be noted that even if you are only coming for a day or a part of the rally, it is always good manners to register as the club needs to know numbers and it gives you a chance to purchase meals and refreshments on the rally and if needs be, call on the services of the back-up trailer. The same ethos exists when visiting other clubs' rallies. Come along and support the rally is the motto!






